## A Tool Used for Labor Induction

The Cesarean Risk Calculator



One out of three inductions end in a c-section and c-sections are associated with an increased risk of short- or long-term complications.



The calculator uses your height, weight, whether you have had a baby before, # of weeks pregnant, and cervical dilation to provide a personalized risk of c-section.



The goal of the calculator is to help manage your labor and give you expectations about your induction.

## We are talking to you about this because:

- You are planning an induction of labor.
- You have had no prior c-sections.



## How will the calculator be used?

At the start of your induction, your care team will calculate your score.

Your care team will discuss your score with you.

Your score is a tool for you and your care team to make decisions together about your labor.
